The windows also have a "turtle tint" so guests will no longer need to close the drapes at night during the "turtle season".

This project is being completed in conjunction with our Super maintenance weeks; so at the same time preventative maintenance is being done to the A/C's, the carpets, drapes, and upholstery is being cleaned and the suites are being deep cleaned after the maintenance crew finishes their check list.
